

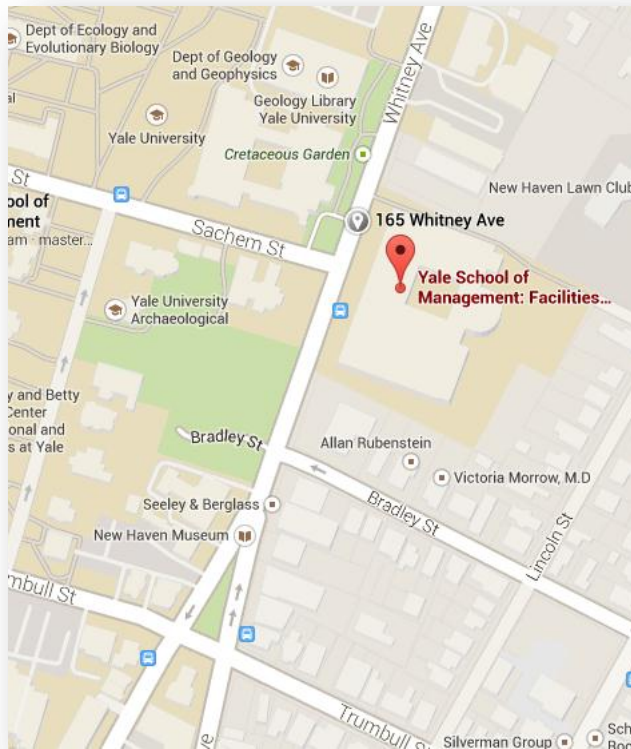

## PROGRAM INFORMATION

## TRAVEL INFORMATION

New Haven is a little less than two hours by train or car from New York City and the New York area airports (JFK, Newark, and LaGuardia). It is also convenient to fly into Bradley International Airport in Hartford, Connecticut, and Tweed Airport in New Haven.



## AIRPORT SHUTTLE

GoShuttle is a cost-effective and convenient way to get from the airport to your hotel in New Haven from Newark, JFK, Laganardia and Bradley (Hartford, Connecticut) airports. The fare for an individual in a "shared van" is about \$70, and if you are traveling as a group, SUVs and shared cars are also available. ## COMMUTER RAIL FROM NEW YORK CITY

The Metro-North train is the best option for travel from New York City to New Haven. It is a commuter train which leaves from Grand Central Station at regular intervals. Travel time is approximately 1 hour and 50 minutes. One-way tickets may be purchased \$22 (off-peak) or \$28 (peak). Seating is not assigned. You can purchase your ticket at the station just before boarding. Tickets may also be purchased on board with cash only and for an extra fee of approximately \$6.
